CURRICULUM

The Gospel Project is a Christ centered Bible curriculum that follows a chronological time-

schoolers! They meet on the $2^{\rm nd}$ & $4^{\rm th}$ Sunday of each month (Conference Room in the Office), following worship in the sanctuary your middle

schooler should check themselves in at the check-in stations prior to the service (no name tag is needed.) They are dismissed after worship directly to the conference room and released by their

teacher at the end of their small group. It is a fun and relaxed atmosphere of fellowship with teachings that focus on using the Gospel as a means of growing in Christ and more fully experiencing His overwhelming love.

OUR PROGRAMS

Family Worship At TKC, after you get your child's nametag, bring all your children in the

service during the worship time. Don't worry! While our church family is happy to hear their squeals, coos and even their cries we realize it can be frustrating and distracting to yourself and others. Just like leaving them in nursery can take time,



so can learning how to behave in the big church. Remember it's a phase and with patience, persistence and some training, the benefits of them learning how to worship God in their own childlike way makes it all worthwhile. Children are learning to stay in their chairs (or at least the aisle), sing along and even be quiet during prayer time. If however, one of your children (PK and under) is struggling during family worship time, we are here to help! Please take them to Rm 4 to be cared for so you can worship with your other children. The workers will then deliver them to their appropriate room when the children are dismissed, where you can pick them up at the end of the service. We hope this will ease any burdens out there and help improve your family worship experience! Each service ends with a short time of worship while children are still in King's King & nursery.

Nursery: 4 Months-Early Preschool

(Rooms 1-4, Downstairs) Our Nursery is divided according to age groups. Toddlers and up are in classes that have a special Bible message and activity designed specifically for their developmental needs. Each room is furnished with ap-

propriate toys and equipment that is regularly cleaned to prevent the spread of germs.

NURSING/QUIET AREA

(Room 3, Downstairs) Nursing mothers and infants to 4 months are welcome to use Room 3 to feed and care for your infant. There is a screened off nursing area with rocking chairs and a livestream of the service with Bluetooth headsets to stay "in" the sermon when you can't be "in" the sermon.

KID'S CHURCH: PREK 4-5TH GRADE

(Rooms 5-8, Upstairs) This group has a great time while learning God's Word through Bible lessons, skits, videos, crafts, music and games! Immediately following Worship in the main sanctuary, they are dismissed from the sanctuary side door to the King's Kids hallway and led upstairs by their teachers. To better accommodate their learning needs, they are divided into PK4 (Rm 5), Lower Elemen-

tary, PK5-1st grade (Rm 8); Middle Elementary, 2nd-3rd grade (Rm 7) and Upper Elementary, 4th-5th grade (Rm 6). The groups have Bible Time, Small Group Activity time, and Bible Memory Time. For each learning unit, children are presented with a "Big Picture Question" and a unit memory



verse brought to life by a Bible story and main point to remember. King's Kids Church is a great opportunity for children to build strong relationships with friends and Jesus Christ.

MIDDLE SCHOOL (GR 6-8) SMALL GROUP

CHECK-IN/OUT PROCEDURE

Your child's safety is important to us! When you arrive at TKC, please check-in your child FIRST at our Check-in stations. Your child will receive a nametag and you will receive a label with a unique security code for your family. All children will be dismissed following worship.

Children in rooms 1-4 need to be escorted by a parent to their rooms.
Children in rooms 5-8 line up inside the sanctuary and are escorted to their classrooms upstairs by their teachers. No child through 5th grade

is allowed into any room without an issued security name tag. Parents must present the security label at check-out for all classes except the Middle school class.
