BE LIKE A CHILD:

 MATTHEW 18:1-4 At that time the disciples came to Jesus, saying, "Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?" ² And calling to him a child, he put him in the midst of them ³ and said, "Truly, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.⁴ Whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

WHO IS THE GREATEST:

- 1 John 2: ¹⁵ Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶ For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life—is not from the Father but is from the world.
- "Truly, I say to you, <u>unless you turn</u> and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven."

TURN

- 2 Corinthians 7:10 -For godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation without regret, whereas worldly grief produces death.
- "Truly, I say to you, unless you turn and <u>become like children</u>, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven."

BECOME LIKE CHILDREN

- Philippians 2: Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant,
- MATTHEW 18:3 "Truly, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven."



CONSEQUENCES – Disqualification

- Enthusiasm-EPH. 6:7 -Rendering service with a good will as to the Lord and not to man
- Effort COL. 3:23 Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men
- Joy Psalm 118: 24 -This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it

GODLY CHILDLIKE QUALITIES

- Humility James 4:6
- Dependence John 15:5
- Trust Isaiah 26:3-4

WE NEED JESUS

- Luke 9:23 And he said to all, "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me.
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me.



Small Group Discussion Questions:

- 1. Proverbs 13:15 KJV says *"....the way of the transgressor is hard."* How do you think that might apply to these two verses?:
 - a. ⁹Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor men who practice homosexuality,
 - b. ¹⁰ nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God.
- 2. What circumstances or challenges make your life hard? What things in your list can you control? What things in your list are out of your control?
- 3. To whom do your bodies belong? (The Lord Jesus Christ who bought them with His blood.)
- 4. In light of belonging to Jesus why should we flee sexual immorality?
- 5. How can we glorify God with our bodies?

Remember leaders: these are only suggested questions and ideas. Trust the Lord to guide and direct you, because He loves you, in any way the Spirit leads!
